2007 RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Harvested: September 26 - October 19, 2007

Blend: 86% Cabernet Sauvignon

8% Cabernet Franc

3% Merlot

3% Petite Verdot

Appellation: Sierra Foothills

Sugar at Harvest: 25.6°Brix

250 cases bottled September, 2009

Winemaking:

The grapes were hand harvested from our View Forever Vineyard Estate at optimal ripeness, then destemmed and fermented in small lots until dryness. The young wine finished malo-lactic in 70% new French oak barrels and matured for 23 months with quarterly racking.

Tasting Notes: Deep violet black color. Aromas of blueberry compote, peppery spice, and pickle aromas with a supple dry-yet-fruity medium-to-full body with a tangy, pomegranate, herb, and earth finish with firm, chewy tannins.

Food Pairing: Try this wine with rich pates, grilled steak with sauted mushrooms and blue cheese, or hearty lasagna with salad.
