Winemaking:

Co-fermented with 5% Viognier, our Syrah was made in small lots, matured in 35% new French oak barrels for 16 months.

Crushed blueberry, cherry cola, and red licorice aromas with a soft, silky fruity-yet-dry medium -to-full body and a warm, peppery, apple sauce and dusty mineral finish.
